

Eden Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes of the February 15, 2016 Meeting
(rescheduled from February 8, 2016 due to inclement weather)

Call-to-Order: Supervisor Randy Kylar called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Attendance: Supervisors Randy Kylar and Joseph Rineer, also Mark Rudy, and the following members of the public: Amos K. Stoltzfus, Menno K. Stoltzfus, Benuel S. Fisher, Luke B. Shirk, Jesse L. Lapp, David B. Smucker, David F. Stoltzfus, Jonas S. King, John S. Stoltzfus, Ivan D. Stoltzfus and Rick McEvoy.

Public Participation: None.

Minutes: The minutes of the January 11, 2016 Supervisors meeting were reviewed. Randy Kylar motioned, Joseph Rineer seconded to approve the minutes; motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report for January 2016, in the amount of \$245,334.44 (attached), was approved on a motion by Randy Kylar and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

Payment of Bills: The list of bills to be paid in February 2016, in the amount of \$28,247.88 (attached), was approved on a motion by Randy Kylar and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

SEO Report: The SEO report listed activity of \$100.00 for the month of January 2016.

Tax Collector's Report: No report.

Zoning Officer's Report: The Zoning Officer's Report listed activity in the amount of \$1,750.80 for the month of January 2016.

A special meeting was scheduled for Monday, March 28, 2016 at 7 pm to adopt the Township's Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance and updated Floodplain Ordinance. Szilvi will ask Janice Longer to advertise. On a motion by Joseph Rineer and second by Randy Kylar, a payment of \$50.00 was approved to the Dept. of Labor and Industry for Gerry Parker's Building Code Official certification. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion by Joseph Rineer and second by Randy Kylar, the Supervisors approved, as recommended by Ed Fisher, returning a \$7,720.00 portion of the escrow held for property improvements for Jacob G. Fisher (114 Pumping Station Rd).

Road Master's Report: Mark Rudy submitted the Road Master's report of activity in January 2016.

Solanco Public Safety Committee: No report.

Emergency Management: No report.

Southern Lancaster County Inter-Municipal Council: No report.

Correspondence: Received correspondence was reviewed and disseminated.

Old Business:

Township Auditors: A motion was made by Joseph Rineer to appoint Judy Landis, Sarah Landis and Ellis Ferguson as Township Auditors. Seconded by Randy Kylar, motion carried unanimously.

CDBG Grant Update: The grant application was submitted for the reconstruction of Furnace Road. The response from residents to return the income surveys was very favorable. The Township is scheduled to present the project before the CDBG Public Improvement Steering Committee in March.

New Business:

PA1 Call Membership: The membership agreement was signed to apply for principal membership (necessary as the Township's population exceeds 2,000 residents).

Public Participation:

Ivan Stoltzfus (501 Furnace Rd) raised concerns about the Township using the snow blower in front of his property during a recent snow storm. A window was broken and snow was blown onto nearby porches. Mark Rudy explained that the blower's chute was angled down and using the snow blower was necessary due to the amount of snow and the layout of the area.

Rick McEvoy (Loop Rd) questioned why the Township's truck didn't stop to help or check on his wife who was stuck in a vehicle on Loop Rd during a recent snow event. Mark Rudy explained that drivers are not supposed to stop to assist stranded motorists during winter maintenance operations.

Adjournment: A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Randy Kylar and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 7:32 PM.
