

Eden Township Board of Supervisors Minutes of the April 11, 2016 Meeting

Call-to-Order: Supervisor David Rineer called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Attendance: Supervisors David Rineer, Randy Kylar and Joseph Rineer, also Mark Rudy, Gerry Parker and Szilvia Troutman, and the following members of the public: Melvin B. Stoltzfus, , Jesse Lapp, David F. Stoltzfus, David B. Smucker, Menno K. Stoltzfus, Benuel S. Fisher, John S. Stoltzfus, Jacob S. King, Blake Huber, Rick McEvoy, Isaac Glick and Cpl. Jamal Pratt.

Public Participation: None.

Minutes: The minutes of the March 14, 2016 Supervisors meeting were reviewed. David Rineer motioned, Randy Kylar seconded to approve the minutes; motion carried unanimously.

The minutes of the March 28, 2016 special meeting were reviewed. David Rineer motioned, Randy Kylar seconded to approve the minutes; motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report for March 2016, in the amount of \$361,017.75 (attached), was approved on a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Randy Kylar; motion carried unanimously.

Payment of Bills: The list of bills to be paid in April 2016, in the amount of \$60,909.23 (attached), was approved on a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Randy Kylar; motion carried unanimously.

SEO Report: The SEO report listed activity of \$0.00 for the month of March 2016.

Tax Collector's Report: The Tax Collector's report listed activity of \$12,639.35 for the month of March 2016.

Zoning Officer's Report: Gerry Parker presented the Zoning Officer's Report in the amount of \$16,763.79 for the month of March 2016.

On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer, the Supervisors unanimously approved releasing \$13,000 of the escrow held for property improvements at 197 Groff Road (Renee Rogers).

Road Master's Report: Mark Rudy submitted the Road Master's report of activity in March 2016.

Solanco Public Safety Committee: No report.

Emergency Management: No report.

Southern Lancaster County Inter-Municipal Council: No report.

Correspondence: Received correspondence was reviewed and disseminated.

Public Participation:

Cpl. Jamal Pratt (PA State Police) shared crime statistics for Eden Township.

Rick McEvoy (235 Loop Rd) inquired what equipment was used to install the pounders at the old D&J driveway off Pumping Station Rd.

Old Business:

CDBG Grant Update: Eden Township was granted \$150,000 for the reconstruction of Furnace Road.

Quarry Edge: Ed Fisher recommended that the wording in the Memorandum of Understanding be changed – the MOU will be signed by the Supervisors once the changes are made.

Public Participation:

Rick McEvoy (235 Loop Rd) asked if the pipe under the old D&J driveway will be taken out. The Supervisors answered yes but explained that no date had been set for the job.

Blake Huber (289 Camargo Rd) expressed concern that the driveway issue be resolved without a lawsuit. David Rineer explained that the pipe across the driveway must be taken out in order to address the water issues on Pumping Station Road and to ensure that the stormwater improvements to be undertaken by Norfolk Southern around Pumping Station Road Bridge will be effective. The Township is not in the position to make any decisions regarding the future of the driveway until all improvements are complete in the area of the bridge.

New Business:

MOU – Stony Hill Rd Bridge Replacement: In addition to Stony Hill Rd and Stone Rd, Springville Rd should be added to the list of municipal detour routes during the replacement of the Stony Hill Rd Bridge. On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer, the Supervisors agreed to sign the updated Memorandum of Understanding. Motion carried unanimously.

Designation of Agent Resolution – FEMA Snow Assistance: On a motion by David Rineer and second by Randy Kylar, the Supervisors approved, under **Resolution #2016-04-11-01**, designating Szilvia Troutman as an agent on behalf of Eden Township to obtain FEMA assistance for expenses incurred during the January 2016 snow storm. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of draft petition to PUC: On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer, the Supervisors approved the draft petition prepared by PennDot in order to save Pumping Station Rd Bridge.

Octoraro Watershed Association: The Octoraro Watershed Assn offered their assistance in requesting the Lancaster Co. Conservation District to visit every farm in Eden Township in an effort to ensure compliance with conservation plan requirements. LCCD is using a similar approach in Bart and Colerain Townships. The Supervisors accepted the Association's offer.

Meeting with Williams Pipeline: Joseph Rineer and Mark Rudy will attend a meeting with Williams Pipeline at 1 pm on April 27 in Drumore Twp about a project involving an existing pipeline.

Piccadilly Hill Rd: Gerry will send a letter to Daniel Stoltzfus about the damage his plow caused on Piccadilly Hill Rd.

Gideon Stoltzfus Stormwater Plan: On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Randy Kylar, the Supervisors approved the stormwater plan for Gideon Stoltzfus (564 Furnace Rd). Motion passed unanimously.

Public Participation: None.

Adjournment: A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by David Rineer and seconded by Joseph Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 8:13 PM.
