

Eden Township Board of Supervisors Minutes of the November 9, 2015 Meeting

Call-to-Order: Supervisor Ellis Ferguson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Attendance: Supervisors Ellis Ferguson, David Rohrer and David Rineer, also Mark Rudy, Gerry Parker and Szilvia Troutman, and the following members of the public: Shawn D. Vinson, Gideon Stoltzfus, David Stoltzfus, Menno K. Stoltzfus, Emanuel F. Stoltzfus, Morgan E. Foos Jr., Ivan D. Stoltzfus, Gary Crawford, Joe Rineer, David B. Smucker, John Stoltzfus; and the following members of the Quarryville Fire Company: Tim Ryan, Leroy Welk, *[illegible signature]* and Jaye Kotchessa.

Public Participation:

Tim Ryan and other members of the Quarryville Fire Company were in attendance to discuss the financial situation of the Fire Company and requested the Township to increase their annual funding to \$15,000 (this is a \$9,400 increase). The additional funding is needed for updating apparatus.

Gary Crawford, Eden Township Tax Collector requested reimbursement for training courses he took as required by the State. Gary completed 5 courses at \$35 each, totaling \$175. The request was approved by the Supervisors.

Minutes: The minutes of the October 20, 2015 Supervisors meeting were reviewed. David Rohrer motioned, David Rineer seconded to approve the minutes, motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report for October 2015, in the amount of \$248,935.10 (attached), was approved on a motion by Ellis Ferguson and seconded by David Rohrer, motion carried unanimously.

Payment of Bills: The list of bills to be paid in November 2015, in the amount of \$30,285.26 (attached), plus \$175.00 as reimbursement to Gary Crawford, was approved on a motion by David Rineer and seconded by David Rohrer, motion carried unanimously.

SEO Report: The SEO report listed activity of \$300.00 for the month of October 2015 (attached).

Tax Collector's Report: The Tax Collector's Report listed activity of \$450.20 for the month of October 2015 (attached).

Zoning Officer's Report: Gerry Parker presented the Zoning Officer's Report in the amount of \$692.20 for the month of October 2015 (attached).

Road Master's Report: Mark Rudy submitted the Road Master's report of activity in October 2015 (attached). Mark was contacted by PennDot with a request to have Pumping Station Road Bridge inspected.

Solanco Public Safety Committee: No report.

Emergency Management: No report.

Southern Lancaster County Inter-Municipal Council: No report.

Correspondence: Received correspondence was reviewed and disseminated.

Old Business:

Rail Trail Environmental Work: Grant funds will be used to cover the cost of the environmental work required on the Rail Trail.

New Business:

CommunityAid: The Township was contacted by the non-profit organization about placing clothing collection bins in the area. The Supervisors agreed that the municipal building was not an ideal location.

Constable Shawn Vinson voiced his interest in being appointed as Emergency Management Coordinator and as a member of the Rail Trail Committee. The appointments will be addressed at the Organizational Meeting in January 2016.

Supervisor David Rohrer handed in his resignation effective November 16, 2015. The resignation was accepted by the Board.

Adjournment: A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Ellis Ferguson and seconded by David Rohrer, motion carried unanimously.
